MITCHAM PARISH CHURCH St Peter & St Paul Anglican Church

Grade II* listed Georgian church built 1820 on site of 13th Century church. Many notable features including tombs and

memorials. Picturesque graveyard.

MITCHAM CRICKET CLUB

Cricket has reputedly been played on this ground since before 1685 - longer than anywhere else in the world. The pavilion, built in 1904, is rare in being separated from the ground by a road. Its balcony offers great views across the cricket ground.

Built 1889 and locally listed.
